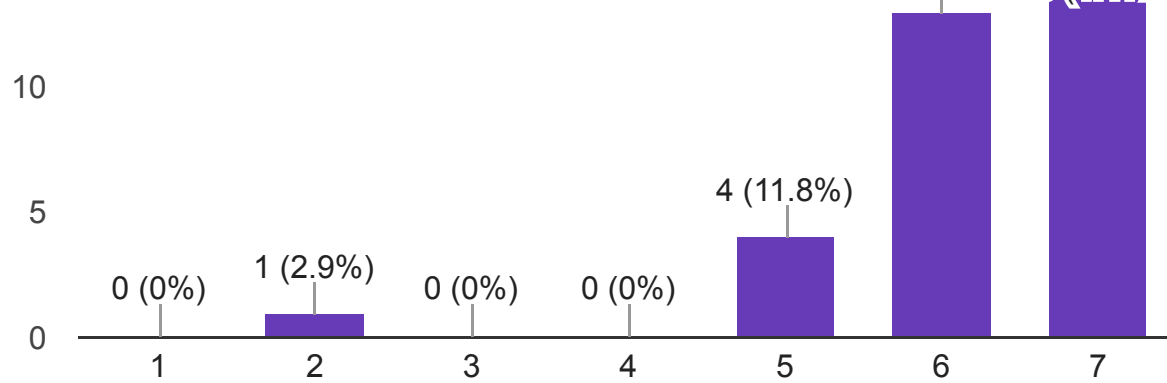


Laryngeal EMG interpretation- RM (34 responses)

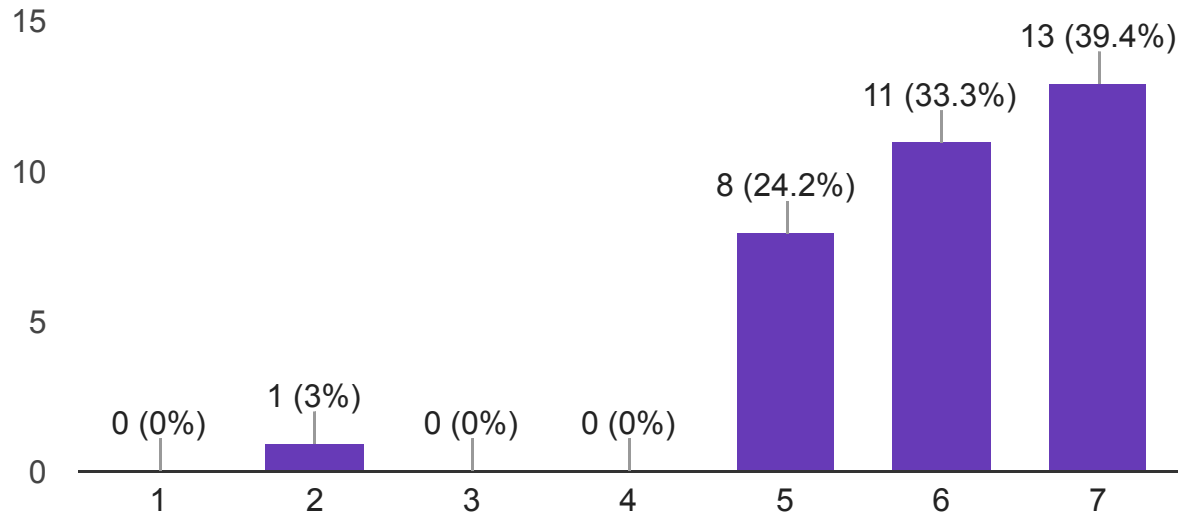

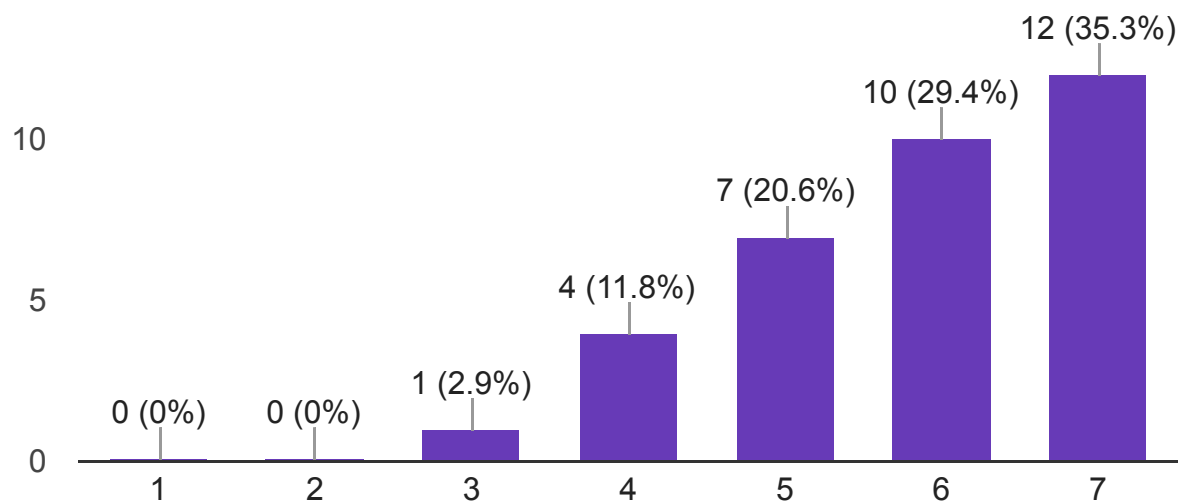

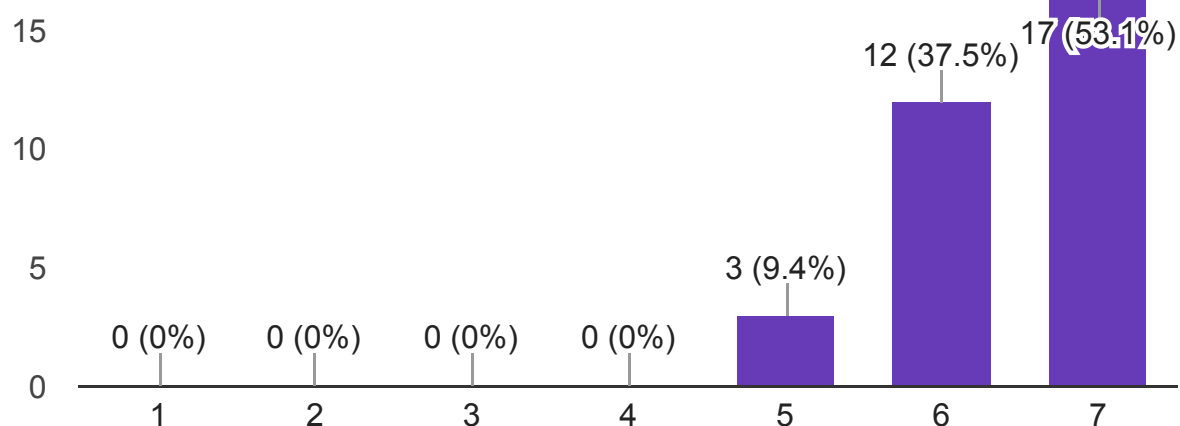

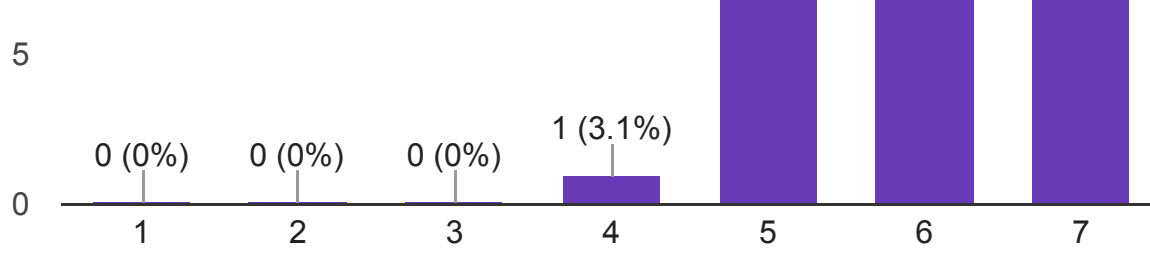

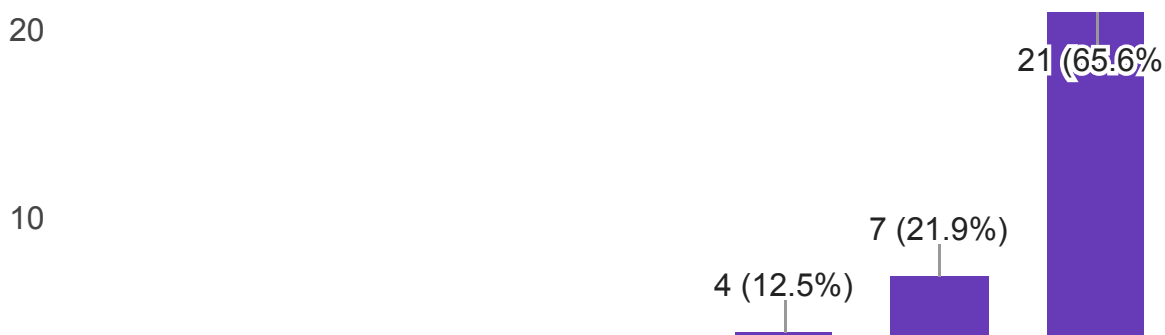
Workshop Injection laryngoplasty (32 responses)

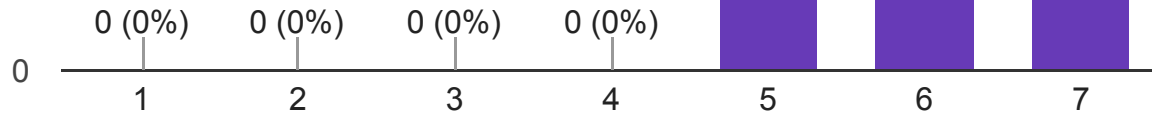


Workshop Laryngeal innervation (34 responses)

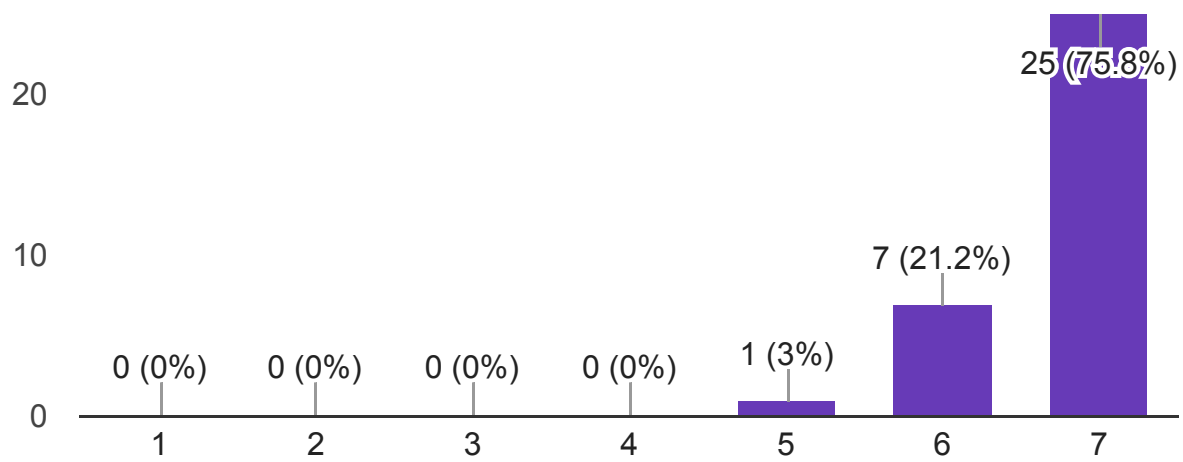


Workshop Laryngeal framework (32 responses)

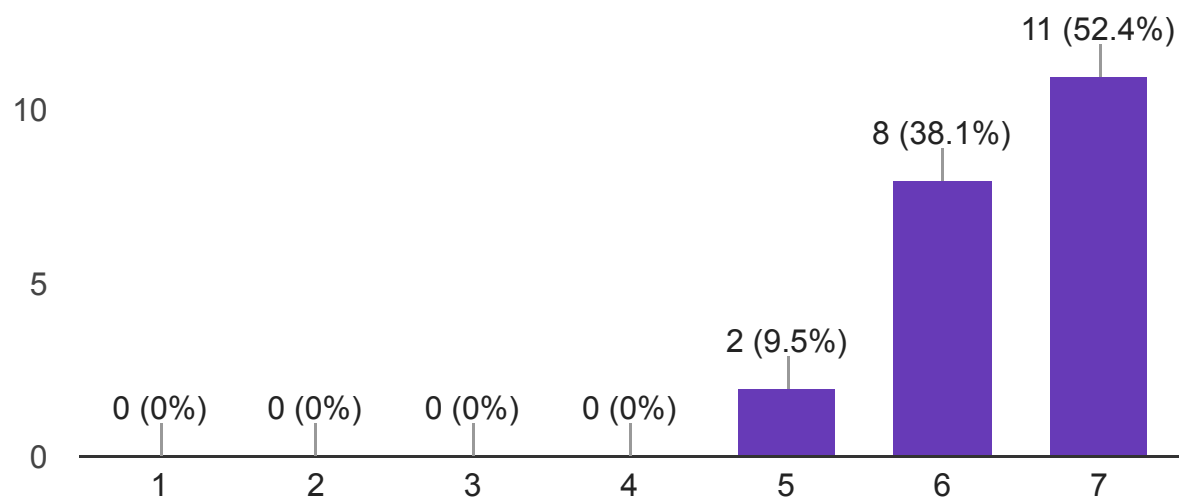




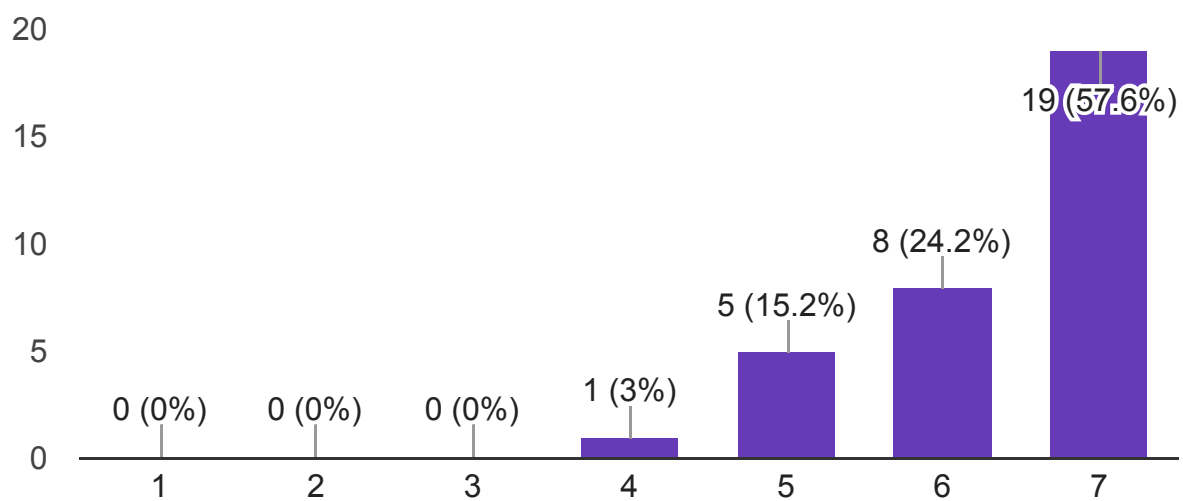

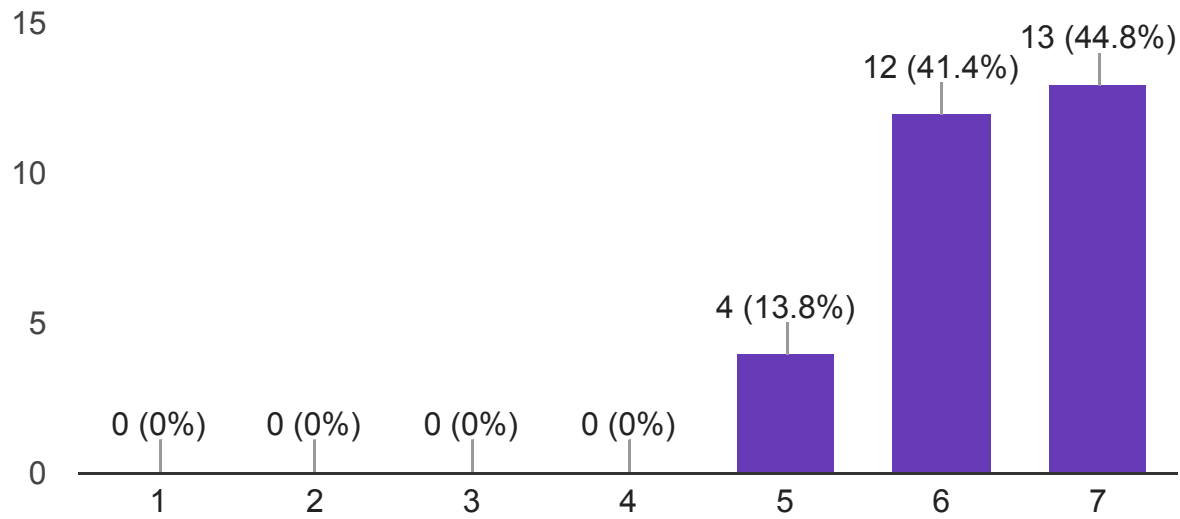


Overall score of the meeting (34 responses)



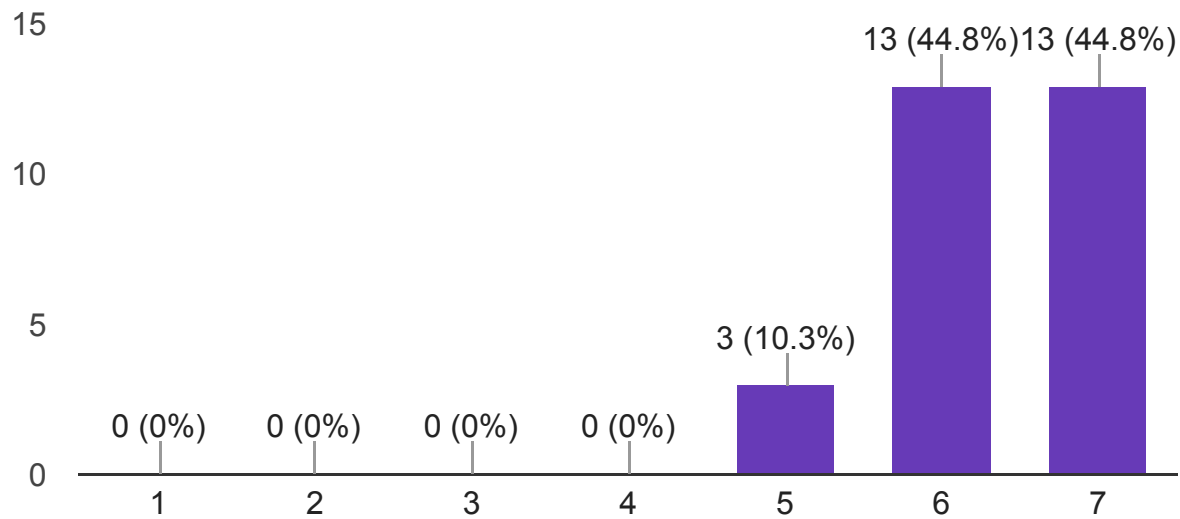

Excellent course. Great food ! Organisation great!

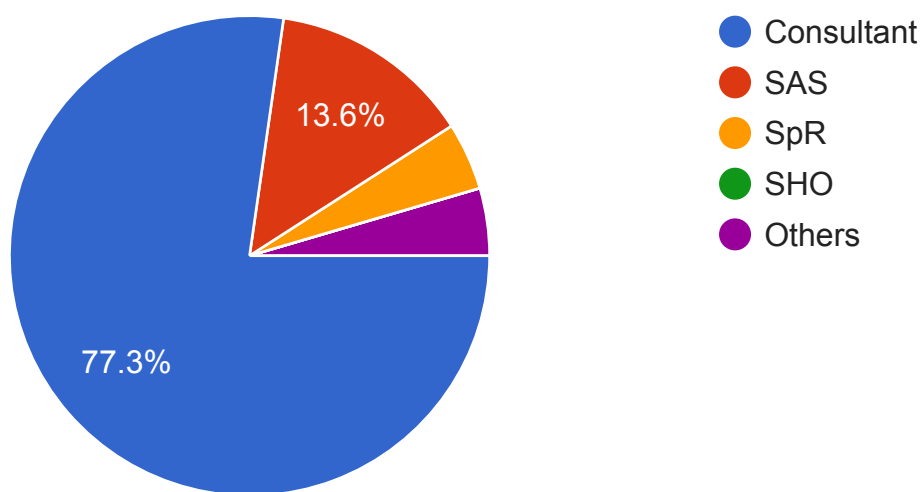
